### **Medical Advocacy:**

Support and advocacy available 24 hours a day at local hospitals to assist survivors who are going through a sexual assault forensic examination.

### **Law Enforcement & Court Advocacy:**

We are here to help survivors navigate every step of the criminal legal system including assistance with protection orders.

### **Support Counseling:**

Support is available to survivors in our office or off-site at a public location that may be more safe and accessible for you.

### **Support Groups:**

### **Therapy Services:**

Therapy services are available for children, teens, and adult survivors at any point in their healing process. Therapy services are also available for friends and loved ones of survivors.

### **Educational Programs:**

Our education programs are intended to educate the community about sexual violence. Presentations can range from 15 minutes during a group meeting to a two-hour protective parenting class. Each class is designed to fit the wishes of the hosting organization. Programs are available for children and adults.
